> We, the Chapters of the National Space Society, do hereby declare our unity

> The name of the organization shall be the National Space Society Chapters'

> a) The Chapters' Assembly shall exist as an advisory body to the NSS, to

> lateral communications among varied chapters of the NSS, as well as between

> The Chapters' Assembly shall hold a public meeting each year at the annual

> A quorum for voting at the full meeting of the CA and subsequent meetings
